Massive Data Breach at Anthem Insurance

February 5, 2015 – Anthem has disclosed that hackers managed to get into the company's computer network and gain access to some of the personally identifiable information on 80 million current and former customers of the company. Data on employees of Anthem was also breached. The breach is one of the largest in history.
